

The Montana Logging Association & MLA Services, Inc, is currently in search of a Northwest Region Representative/Safety Consultant. This position will be based out of the Montana Logging Association's headquarters located in Kalispell, Montana.

Job Duties include but not limited to the following:

Primary duty entails on-site inspection of timber harvesting operations for safety compliance as per Federal and State regulations. A strong understanding of various logging systems is desired. Candidate reports to and works closely with insurance and logging companies to reduce work related accidents/injuries. Candidate should have a clean driving record and be familiar with traveling on forest and logging system roads. Also, a strong understanding of DOT requirements pertaining to the trucking industry is recommended.

Candidate will also conduct safety inspections for retail lumber yards, truss/wall panel plants, equipment/parts stores, post/pole operations and small sawmill operations. A good understanding of industrial safety regulations is desired. Candidate will also participate in conducting/teaching yearly First Aid/CPR and Wildland Fire (RT 130) training. Public speaking and organizational skills are strongly desired.

Candidate will be required to attend and participate in various meetings pertaining to forestry issues primarily in the Northwest Region of Montana but may also include forestry issues on a state and/or national level. Candidate will also work closely with the MLA's Accredited Logging Professional Program and its various workshops including Best Management Practices and Streamside Management Zones. A background in Forestry or related field is desired.

This position requires an individual that is a team player and is very self-motivated. Candidate will be responsible for scheduling, planning and coordinating their own work activities to meet weekly, monthly and quarterly objectives. Some travel is required with this position.
